## LEADLINE DIVISION AHS Points in Class #1

ENTRY FEE: \$5.00 per class

Open to children six (6) years of age or under. To be judged on manners and suitability of mount to rider. Not eligible for any other Non-Leadline classes.

- 101. Leadline Walk Only
- 1. AHS Leadline will be asked to trot
- 102. Off Leaders handler to stay with rider

#### MINI STIRRUP DIVISION

Open to riders eight (8) and younger. Riders may not cross enter into any jumping classes at this same horse show. Riders are eligible for any appropriate flat class.

- 2. Mini Stirrup Walk Trot Equitation
- 3. Mini Stirrup Pleasure
- 4. Mini Stirrup Figure 8 Equitation
- 5. Mini Stirrup Equitation Cavaletti Poles 4 on the outside track

#### SHORT STIRRUP EQUITATION DIVISION

Open to Juniors twelve (12) years of age and under on horses and ponies who have not competed in any show over fences exceeding 2'. Judged on hands, seat, general appearance, and control of mount.

- 7. Short Stirrup Walk-Trot-Canter
- 8. Short Stirrup Equitation Fences 4 fences
- 9. Short Stirrup Equitation Fences 8 fences

#### SHORT STIRRUP HUNTER DIVISION

Open to riders twelve (12) years of age and under. Riders to jump a simple course of eight (8) fences at 18". Rider and horse/pony combination may only cross enter into Short Stirrup Eq. and Pleasure at same show.

- 10-12. Short Stirrup Hunter Over Fences
- 13. Short Stirrup Hunter Under Saddle

#### LESSON MOUNT DIVISION

Open to all riders on horses or ponies used solely in lesson programs. Judged on hands, seat, general appearance and control of mount. Rider may not have shown higher than crossrails at any show. May use any tack used in a schooling program.

- 14. Lesson Mount Walk Trot
- 15. Lesson Mount Walk Trot Pleasure
- 16. Lesson Mount Walk Trot Individual Canter
- 17. Lesson Mount Cavaletti 4 poles on the track

#### BEGINNER EQUITATION DIVISION

Open to Junior riders who have not shown in more than eight (8) horse shows in any one year. Riders cannot jump more than 2' in any horse show. It is hoped that people will use discretion when entering and be mindful of the spirit of this division.

- 18. Beginner Equitation Walk-Trot
- 19. Beginner Equitation Walk-Trot-Canter
- 20. Beginner Equitation Fences 4 fences
- 21. Beginner Equitation Fences 8 fences

#### LONG STIRRUP DIVISION

Open to adult amateur riders on horses or ponies. Adults may not have jumped higher than 2'6" at any horse show. Riders are not eligible for any jumping classes other than Modified Hunter.

- 22. Long Stirrup Walk-Trot
- 23. Long Stirrup Walk-Trot-Canter
- 24. Long Stirrup Two Crossrails
- 25. Long Stirrup Four Crossrails

#### MODIFIED HUNTER DIVISION

Open to all amateur and junior riders on horses and ponies. Riders may not have shown higher than 2'3" at any show. May only cross enter into Long Stirrup, Beginner Eq., or Pleasure, and 2' Equitation at same show. Fences to be at 2'. Horse and rider combination may not ride in division for more than two (2) years.

26-28. Modified Hunter Over Fences29. Modified Hunter Under Saddle

#### PLEASURE DIVISION AHS Points in Class #30

Open to juniors or adults on any type of horse or pony suitable for use as a pleasure mount. To be judged on performance, manners, and soundness. No martingales.

#### BABY GREEN HUNTER DIVISION

Open to horses/ponies who have not shown over fences in any class prior to December 1st of the preceding year. Ponies to jump 2' and horses 2'3". Trotting corners will not be penalized.

- 34. Baby Green Hunter Under Saddle

#### LOW SCHOOLING HUNTER DIVISION

Open to all riders on horses or ponies. Judged on manners, performance, way of going and soundness.

Fences at 2' and 2'3" at the rider's discretion to be stated on the entry blank.

- 35-37. Low Schooling Hunter Over Fences
- 38. Low Schooling Hunter Under Saddle

#### HIGH SCHOOLING HUNTER DIVISION

Open to all riders on horses or ponies. Judged on manners, performance, way of going and soundness.

Fences at 2'6" and 3' at the rider's discretion to be stated on the entry blank.

- 39-41 High Schooling Hunter Over Fences
- 42. High Schooling Hunter Under Saddle

#### PRE-CHILDREN'S HUNTER DIVISIONS

Open to horses and ponies ridden by junior riders who have not won three or more blue ribbons in horsemanship over fences at any rated show, except Mini Stirrup, Short Stirrup and Beginner Equitation. Judged on manners, performance, way of going and soundness. Ponies to jump 2', horses 2'6".

43-45. Pre-Children's Hunter Pony Over Fences

46. Pre-Children's Hunter Pony Under Saddle

47-49 Pre-Children's Hunter Horse Over Fences

50. Pre-Children's Hunter Horse Under Saddle

#### 2' EQUITATION DIVISION

Open to junior and adult amateur riders on horses or ponies. Riders may not have competed at 2'3" or higher.

- 51-52. 2' Equitation Over Fences
- 53. 2' Equitation on the Flat

#### PRELIMINARY ADULT HUNTER DIVISION

Open to Adult Amateur riders on either ponies or horses. Fences 2'6". Riders may not cross enter into Modified Hunter or Long Stirrup Divisions at the same show.

- 57. Preliminary Adult Hunter Under Saddle

#### CHILDREN'S HUNTER DIVISION

Open to horses and ponies ridden by juniors. Sm/Med to jump 2', Lg 2'6", horses 3'. May not cross enter into any Pre-Children's Hunter class or division on the same mount.

58-60. Children's Hunter Over Fences61. Children's Hunter Under Saddle

#### 2'6" EQUITATION DIVISION

Open to junior and adult amateur riders on horses or ponies. Rider may not have competed at 2'9" or higher.

62-63. 2'6" Equitation Over Fences64. 2'6" Equitation on the Flat

#### 2'9" EQUITATION DIVISION

Open to junior and adult amateur riders on horses or ponies.

65-66. 2'9" Equitation Over Fences 67. 2'9" Equitation on the Flat

#### WALK-TROT DIVISION

Open to juniors and adult amateurs on horses or ponies. Riders may not cross enter into any cantering or jumping class.

- 68. **Walk Equitation** riders will be asked to walk both ways of the ring, may be asked to halt and stand, and may be asked simple questions in basic horsemanship
- 69. **Walk-Trot Equitation** riders will be asked to walk and trot both ways of the ring
- 70. **Walk-Trot Pleasure** to be judged on the horse/pony manners and performance

#### SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. Pre-entries can be made by mail, phone or Fax. Post entries will be accepted but pre-entries will be most appreciated.
- 2 All hunter classes will be judged on performance and soundness with emphasis on soundness and manners unless otherwise noted.
- 3. The Worcester Stables Horse Show, Worcester Stables Inc., Briarwood Farms, Inc., Katie Benson, or the Committee will not be responsible for any accident, loss or damage which may occur to any horse, rider or equipment before, during or after the show.
- 4. Should any question arise that is not covered in the USEF Rule book the same shall be referenced to the Show Committee whose decision shall be final.
- 5. Failure to enter the ring within three minutes of being called will incur elimination.
- 6. All fees must be paid and entry complete before numbers can be issued.
- 7. The Committee reserves the right to cancel, combine, change location or add any class(es) or schooling deemed necessary.
- 8. All riders must wear proper attire including proper headgear at all times mounted on the showgrounds.
- 9. Championships will be awarded at the conclusion of the division at the show office.
- 10. All pets must be leashed.
- 11. It is a condition of entry to the showgrounds that these rules and regulations be read, understood and accepted.
- 12. A processing fee of \$40.00 will be made for all non-

**FROM THE NORTH WEST NJ**: Take Rt. 202 South, turn right onto Rt. 73 West, turn left onto Berks road to end, turn left to the farm on the left

**FROM PHILA:** Rt. 76 West to Plymouth Mtg., (Exit #333) getting on Rt. 476 to Germantown Pike West. Stay on the Germantown Pike and once you pass THROUGH the intersection of Rt. 202 THEN start counting nine more lights to turn right onto Potshop Road, follow to end, turn left and make a quick right to the farm on the right

**FROM KING OF PRUSSIA**: Take 422 West to the Trooper/ Audubon exit, follow to the Germantown Pike turn right, next light Potshop Road turn left, follow to end, turn left and then a quick right to the farm on the right

**FROM PA TNPK:** Exit #333 for Norristown, follow signs for Plymouth Rd., left at light, go 300 yds to make right onto Germantown Pike West, follow to intersection of Rt. 202 THEN start counting nine more lights to make a right onto Potshop Rd., follow to end, make left and quick right to the farm on the right
