General Information

1. Entry fee: \$20.00 per class for entries received by 6/24/17. Post entries \$25.00 per class. AHS Derby \$10
2. Neither the horse show committee Once Upon A Farm nor Jentri Stables will be responsible for any damage, injury or loss to persons, horse/pony or property of exhibitor or spectator incurred on or off the horse show grounds.
3. The management reserves the right to divide, combine, cancel or change the order of classes when necessary.
4. Anyone or any horse suspended from the USEF will not be permitted to show at an Associated Horse Show.
5. Classes for Juniors will be limited to riders who have not reached their 18th birthday prior to December 1, 2016.
6. All riders must be wearing an ASTM approved helmet while mounted.
7. The decision of the Judge and/or Steward will be final.
8. No martingales permitted in under saddle classes.
9. Schooling permitted until 7:45 A.M. and before each division. Schooling may be regulated dependent upon entries
10. All fence heights are approximate.
11. The show is generally held despite inclement weather, but will be cancelled in case of extremely heavy rain. Call if in doubt.
12. Three in a division MUST run as a division. A division with two entries may run for lesser points or be combined with appropriate division at show managers discretion. Decision to be made before division begins.
13. PLEASE LEAVE YOUR DOGS AT HOME.

Class Descriptions

- Leadline:** Open to children six (6) years of age or under. Will be asked to trot. Not eligible for any other non-leadline classes.
- Junior-Adult Pleasure:** Open to any type of pony or horse suitable for use as a pleasure mount. To be ridden by a junior or adult. Judged on performance, manners, and suitability of mount to rider. No martingales.
- Mini Stirrup:** Open to juniors eight (8) years and younger. Riders may not cross enter into any jumping classes at the same horse show. Riders are eligible for any appropriate flat class.
- Short Stirrup Equitation:** Open to children twelve(12) years of age and under on horses and ponies who have not competed in any show over fences exceeding 2'. Fences at x-rails.
- Short Stirrup Hunter:** Open to riders twelve (12) years of age and under. Riders to jump a simple course of eight (8) fences at 18". Horse/pony/rider combo may only cross enter into Short Stirrup Equitation and Junior Pleasure at the same show.
- Beginner Equitation:** Open to all juniors who have not shown in more than eight (8) horse shows in any one year. Fences at x-rails. Riders cannot jump more than 2' in any horse show and may only cross enter into Modified Hunter.
- Lesson Mount:** Open to all riders on horses or ponies used solely in lesson programs. Rider may not have shown higher than x-rails at any show. May use any tack used in a schooling program. Fences at cross rails.
- Walk/Trot:** Open to junior and adult amateur riders on horses or ponies. Riders may not cross enter into any cantering or jumping classes.
- Modified Hunter:** Open to all Junior and Adult amateur riders on horses and ponies. Rider may not have shown higher than 2'3" in any show. May only cross enter into Long Stirrup, Beginner Eq, 2' Eq, or pleasure at same show. Fences to be at 2'

Baby Green Hunter: Open to horses or ponies who are in their 1st or 2nd year of showing over fences. Ponies to jump 2'. Horses to jump 2'3". Trotting corners will not be penalized.

Low Schooling Hunter: Open to all riders on horses or ponies. Fences at 2' or 2'3' at rider's discretion, to be designated on entry form.

High Schooling Hunter: Open to all riders on horses or ponies. Judged on performance, way of going, manners and soundness. Fences at 2'6 or 3' at rider's discretion, to be designated on entry form.

Thoroughbred Hunter: Open to all Thoroughbred horses/ponies. Fences to be at 2'3" or 2'9" at riders' discretion.

Pre-Children's Hunter Horse/Pony: Open to junior riders still eligible for Novice Equitation Over Fences at any rated show (have not won three blue ribbons in equitation). Horses to jump at 2'6", Ponies to jump 2'. May not cross enter into any Children's Hunter class or division on same mount.

Children's Hunter: Open to horses and ponies ridden by juniors. Small/medium ponies, fences 2'. Large ponies, fences 2'6" and horses, fences 3'.

Pre-Adult Hunter: Open to adult amateur riders on either ponies or horses. Fence heights to be at 2'6". Riders may not cross enter into Modified Hunter or Long Stirrup Division at the same show.

Long Stirrup: Open to adult amateur riders on horses or ponies. Adults may not have jumped higher than 2'6" at any horse show. Riders are not eligible for any jumping classes other than Adult Modified Hunter.

2' Equitation: Open to junior and adult amateur riders on horses or ponies. Riders may not have competed at 2'3" or higher.

2'6" Equitation: Open to junior and adult amateur riders on horses or ponies. Riders may not have competed at 2'9" or higher.

2'9" Equitation: Open to junior and adult amateur riders on horses or ponies.

LowSchooling Jumpers: Open to all riders on horses and ponies. Jumps to be at 2'. Time allowed will be generous (350m/min). (See USEF Rulebook for Table descriptions).

Inter. Schooling Jumpers: Same as Low Schooling Jumpers. Fences at 2'6".

High Schooling Jumpers: Same as Low Schooling Jumpers. Fences at 3'.

AHS 2' Derby: Open to all riders on horses and ponies who have shown this season at 2'3" and under. Riders and horses/ponies must be members of the AHS and must compete in an AHS division at this show. Riders must have competed at least three times at an AHS Show during the current season, as well as the horse/pony – but not necessarily as a horse/rider combination. Fences 2' with 2'3" options. To be run in two rounds. Top eight from first round to come back for a handy round. Sashes awarded through eighth place.

Gambler's Choice: Open to juniors and adults on horses and ponies. Each jump in the ring will be assigned a point value based on difficulty. The rider will have 60 seconds to accumulate as many points as possible. Jumps may be jumped twice and can be approached from both directions. If a jump is knocked down or refused, points will not count. A knocked down jump may not be attempted again. After the bell sounds for completion of the round, the rider must cross a designated finish line. After crossing the finish line, the rider may choose to jump the "Joker" jump worth 200 pts. If the rider clears the jump, 200 points will be added to the score. If the jump is refused or knocked down 200 points will be deducted from the score.
