## GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Entry fee: \$20.00 for pre-entries; \$22.00 at the show.
2. Neither the AHS horse show association nor Sommerfield Stables, will be responsible for any damage, injury, or loss to persons, horse/pony or property of exhibitor or spectator incurred on or off the horse show grounds.
3. The management reserves the right to divide, combine, cancel or change the order of classes when necessary.
4. Anyone or any horse suspended from the AHSA will not be permitted to show at an Associated Horse Show.
5. Classes for Juniors will be limited to riders who have not reached their 18th birthday prior to December 1, 2016.
6. Trophy and six ribbons awarded in each class, with Championship Divisions.
7. Hard hats must be worn in every class and while schooling. Harness required for Juniors.
8. The decision of the Judge and/or Steward will be final.
9. No martingales permitted in under saddle classes except lesson mount.
10. All fence heights are approximate.
11. The show is generally held despite inclement weather, but will be cancelled in case of snow or ice. Call if in doubt.
12. For your own safety, schooling may be regulated by the show management, dependent upon entries.
13. 3 people must compete in each class in order for points to be given towards the AHS year end Awards, classes may be run with 2 entries, awarding 3 points for first place and 2 points for 2<sup>nd</sup>.

### Junior/Adult Pleasure

Open to any type of pony or horse suitable for use as a pleasure mount. To be ridden by a junior or adult. Judged on performance, manners, and suitability of mount or rider. No martingales.

### Leadline – AHS points

Open to children six (6) years of age or under. To be judged on manners and suitability of mount to rider. May be asked to trot. Not eligible for any other classes. AHS points designated to only one class per horse show written to these specifications.

\*\* Martingales are not permitted in the flat phase of the test.

### Modified Hunter:

Open to all junior and adult amateur riders on horses or ponies. Riders may not have jumped higher than 2'3" at any show. May only cross enter into long stirrup, Beginner Eq., Pleasure, and 2' Equitation at same show.

### Baby Green Hunter

Open to horses or ponies who are in their 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> year of showing over fences. Ponies to jump 2'. Horses to jump 2'3". Trotting corners will not be penalized.

### Lesson Mount:

Open to all riders on horses and ponies used solely in lesson programs. Judged on hands, seat, general appearance, and control of mount. Rider may not have shown higher than cross-rails at any show.

### Mini Stirrup Division – AHS points

Open to juniors eight (8) years and younger. Riders may not cross enter into any jumping classes at the same horse show. Riders are eligible for any appropriate flat class. One class of four (4) cross rails or poles may be offered in this division. Poles or cross rails must be specified in prize list.

**Pre-Children's Hunter Division – PONY – AHS points**

Open to junior riders still eligible for Novice Equitation Over Fences at any rated show (have not won three blue ribbons in equitation). Judged on manners, performance, way of going, and soundness. Ponies to jump at 2'. **May not cross enter into any Children's Hunter class or division. Three (3) in a division MUST be run as a division. A division with two (2) entries may run for lesser points or be combined with appropriate division at show managers discretion. Decision to be made before division begins.**

**Pre-Children's Hunter Division – HORSE – AHS points**

Open to junior riders still eligible for Novice Equitation Over Fences at any rated show (have not won three blue ribbons in equitation). Judged on manners, performance, way of going, and soundness. Horses to jump at 2'6". **May not cross enter into any Children's Hunter class or division. Three (3) in a division MUST run as division. A division with two (2) entries may run for lesser points or be combined with appropriate division at show managers discretion. Decision to be made before division begins.**

**Low Schooling Hunter – AHS points**

Open to all riders on horses or ponies. Judged on performance, way of going, manners and soundness. Fences at 2' or 2'3" at rider's discretion. **Three (3) in a division MUST be run as a division. A division with two (2) entries may run for lesser points or be combined with appropriate division at show managers discretion. Decision to be made before division begins.**

**High Schooling Hunter - AHS points**

Open to all riders on horses or ponies. Judged on performance, way of going, manners and soundness. Fences at 2'6" or 3' at rider's discretion. **Three (3) in a division MUST run as a division. A division with two (2) entries may run for lesser points or be combined with appropriate division at show managers discretion. Decision to be made before divisions begins.**

**Intermediate Schooling Jumpers**

**Same specs as Low Schooling Jumpers except jumps 2'6" Schooling Jumpers Table II, 2(b) Schooling Jumpers Table II, 2(b) Schooling Jumpers Table II, 2(b)**

**Low Schooling Jumpers – AHS points**

Open to all riders on horses and ponies. Courses must be run as Table IIa, Table IIb, Table IIc, or Table V (Optimum Time). Jumps to be at 1'9" and/or 2'. Time allowed will be generous (350m/min). (See USEF Rulebook for Table descriptions).

**High Schooling Jumpers – AHS points**

Open to all riders on horses and ponies. Courses must be run as Table IIa, Table IIb, Table IIc, or Table V (Optimum Time). Jumps to be at 2'9". Time allowed will be generous (350m/min). (See USEF Rulebook for Table descriptions)

**Short Stirrup Equitation- AHS points**

Open to children 12 years of age & younger, who have not competed in any show over fences exceeding 2'. Open to horses & ponies. Judges on hand, seat, & control of mount.

**Beginner Equitation- AHS points**

Open to riders under 18 years of age who have not shown in more than 8 shows in any one year. Rider's may not jump more than 2' in any horse show, and may only cross enter into JR. Modified Hunter.

**Long Stirrup- AHS points**

Open to Adult Amateur riders on horses or ponies. Riders may not have jumped higher than 2'6" at any show. Riders are not eligible for any other jumping.

**Pre Adult Hunter- AHS points**

Open to amateur riders on horses and ponies. Riders may not cross Enter into Modified Hunter of Long Stirrup Hunter Divisions at the Same show. Fences 2'6".

**Walk-Trot Division**

Open to juniors and adult amateurs on horses or ponies. Riders may not cross enter into any cantering or jumping class at this same show.

**2' Equitation**

Open to Junior and Adult Amateur on horse or ponies. Riders may not have competed at 2'3" or higher. To be judged on hand seat, and control of mount. May be combined with the 2'6" & 2'9" EQ

**2'6" Equitation**

Open to Junior and Adult Amateur on horse or ponies. Riders may not have competed at 2'9" or higher. To be judged on hand seat, and control of mount. May be combined with the 2' & 2'9" EQ

**2' 9" Equitation**

Open to Junior and Adult Amateur on horse or ponies. To be judged on hand seat, and control of mount. May be combined with the 2'6" & 2' EQ

**Short Stirrup Hunter Division – AHS points**

Open to riders twelve (12) years of age and under. Riders to jump a simple course of eight (8) fences at 18". **Riders and horse/pony Combination** may only cross enter into Short Stirrup Eq. and Pleasure at same show.

**Thoroughbred Hunter**

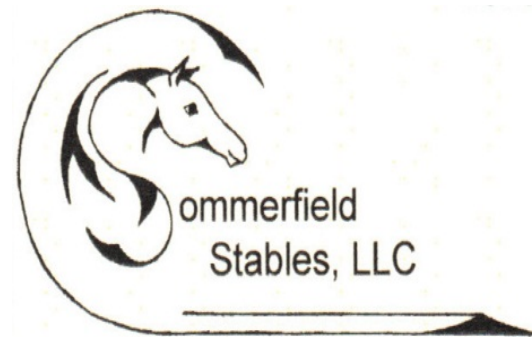
Open to all thoroughbred horses/ponies. Judged on performance, way of going and soundness. Fences to be 2'3" or 2'9" at riders discretion. Not to be combined with any other division.

**Children's Hunter**

Open to horses and ponies ridden by juniors. Judged on manners, performance, way of going and suitability of mount to rider. Small/medium ponies, fences 2'. Large ponies, fences 2'6". Horses, fences 3'. May not cross enter into any Pre-children's Hunter class or division on same mount. A division with two entries may run for lesser points.
