

Rules and Regulations: Entry fee \$20/class until noon on Saturday before the show. **Post Entries \$25/class.**

- Neither the horse show committee, Associated Horse Shows, nor Jentri Stables will be responsible for any damage, injury or loss to persons, horse/pony or property of exhibitor or spectator incurred on or off the horse show grounds.
- Management reserves the right to divide, combine, cancel or change the order of classes if necessary.
- Any person or horse suspended from USEF will not be permitted to participate in an Associated Horse Show as owner, trainer or rider.
- Classes for Junior riders will be limited to riders who have not yet reached their 18th birthday prior to December 1, 2016.
- ASTM/SEI Approved helmets must be worn by ALL riders when mounted.
- Trophy and six ribbons awarded in each class, champion and reserve awarded in all divisions with 3 or more entries.
- The decision of the judge is final.
- Martingales not permitted in under saddle classes.
- Please note the designated 10 minute schooling breaks listed on the prizelist. Please school promptly. Each break will be ended promptly at 10 minutes!! Exhibitor and trainer cooperation is appreciated!
- Fence heights are approximate.
- Please leave your dogs at home.**

Junior/Adult Pleasure: Open to any type of pony or horse suitable for use as a pleasure mount. To be ridden by a junior or adult. Judged on performance, manners, and suitability of mount to rider. No martingales.

Leadline: Open to children six (6) years of age or under. To be judged on manners and suitability of mount to rider. Will be asked to trot. Not eligible for any other non-leadline classes. Show management may offer additional leadline classes such as walk, command, off-lead, or pleasure. AHS points designated to only the walk/trot class.

2' Equitation Division. Open to junior and adult amateur riders on horses or ponies. Riders may not have competed at 2'3" or higher. To be judged on hands, seat, and control of mount. Division will consist of two (2) over fence classes and one (1) flat class. A division with two (2) entries may run for lesser points or be combined with 2'6" or 2'9" Equitation. Decision to be made before division begins.

2'6" Equitation Division. Open to junior and adult amateur riders on horses or ponies. Riders may not have competed at 2'9" or higher. To be judged on hands, seat, and control of mount. Division will consist of two (2) over fence

classes and one (1) flat class. A division with two (2) entries may run for lesser points or be combined with 2' or 2'9" Equitation.

2'9" Equitation Division. Open to junior and adult amateur riders on horses or ponies. To be judged on hands seat, and control of mount. Division will consist of two (2) over fences classes and one (1) flat class. A division with two (2) entries may run for lesser points or be combined with 2' or 2'6" Equitation.

Modified Hunter. Open to all Junior and Adult amateur riders on horses and ponies. Rider may not have shown higher than 2'3" in any show. May only cross enter into Long Stirrup, Beginner Eq, 2' Eq, or pleasure at same show. Fences to be at 2'. A division with two (2) entries may run for lesser points. Decision to be made before division begins. Horse and rider combination may not ride in division for more than two (2) years.

Baby Green Hunter Division. Open to horses/ponies in their first or second year of showing over fences. Ponies to jump 2' and horses 2'3. Trotting corners will not be penalized.

Beginner Equitation Division. Open to all juniors who have not shown in more than eight (8) horse shows in any one year. The division will include a walk/trot; walk/trot/canter and a choice of one (1) or two (2) jumping classes of 4-8 fences at x-rails. Riders cannot jump more than 2' in any horse show and may only cross enter into Modified Hunter. It is hoped that people will use discretion when entering and be mindful of the spirit of this division. If entries do not warrant division to run, it may be combined with Long Stirrup Equitation.

Children's Hunter Division. Open to horses and ponies ridden by juniors. Judged on manners, performance, way of going, and suitability of mount to rider. Small/medium ponies, fences 2'. Large ponies, fences 2'6" and horses, fences 3'. May not cross enter into any Pre-Children's Hunter class or division on same mount. A division with two (2) entries may run for lesser point.

Lesson Mount Division. Open to all riders on horses or ponies used solely in lesson programs. Judged on hands, seat, general appearance, and control of mount. Rider may not have shown higher than x-rails at any show. Recommended classes: 1. walk/trot equitation; 2. walk/trot pleasure; 3. walk/trot/canter; 4. a simple course of four (4) poles or x-rails (must be specified in prize list). May use any tack used in a schooling program.

Long Stirrup Equitation Division. Open to adult amateur riders on horses or ponies. Adults may not have jumped higher than 2'6" at any horse show. Riders are not eligible for any jumping classes other than Adult Modified Hunter. Recommended classes: equitation walk/trot; equitation walk/trot/canter; and

equitation over four (4) cross rails. If entries do not warrant division to run, it may be combined with Beginner Equitation.

Mini Stirrup Division. Open to juniors eight (8) years and younger. Riders may not cross enter into any jumping classes at the same horse show. Riders are eligible for any appropriate flat class. One class of four (4) cross rails or poles may be offered in this division. Poles or cross rails must be specified in prize list.

Pre-Adult Hunter Division. Open to adult amateur riders on either ponies or horses. Fence heights to be at 2'6". Riders may not cross enter into Modified Hunter or Long Stirrup Division at the same show. If entries do not warrant division to run, it may be combined with Pre-Children's Hunter.

Pre-Children's Hunter Division – PONY. Open to junior riders still eligible for Novice Equitation Over Fences at any rated show (have not won three blue ribbons in equitation). Judged on manners, performance, way of going, and soundness. Ponies to jump at 2'. May not cross enter into any Children's Hunter class or division on same mount. A division with two (2) entries may run for lesser points or be combined with Pre-Adult Hunter or Pre-Children's Hunter Horse. Decision to be made before division begins.

Pre-Children's Hunter Division – HORSE. Open to junior riders still eligible for Novice Equitation Over Fences at any rated show (have not won three blue ribbons in equitation). Judged on manners, performance, way of going, and soundness. Horses to jump at 2'6". May not cross enter into any Children's Hunter class or division on same mount. A division with two (2) entries may run for lesser points or be combined with Pre-Adult Hunter or Pre-Children's Hunter Pony.

Low Schooling Hunter. Open to all riders on horses or ponies. Judged on performance, way of going, manners and soundness. Fences at 2' or 2'3 at rider's discretion, to be designated on entry form. A division with two (2) entries may run for lesser points or be combined with High Schooling Hunter. Decision to be made before division begins.

High Schooling Hunter. Open to all riders on horses or ponies. Judged on performance, way of going, manners and soundness. Fences at 2'6 or 3' at rider's discretion, to be designated on entry form. A division with two (2) entries may run for lesser points or be combined with Low Schooling Hunter. Decision to be made before division begins.

Short Stirrup Equitation Division. Open to children twelve(12) years of age and under on horses and ponies who have not competed in any show over fences exceeding 2'. Judged on hands, seat, general appearance, and control of mount. Recommended classes; 1. walk/trot; 2. walk/trot/canter; and 3. A simple course of 4-8 cross rails at 18".

Short Stirrup Hunter Division. Open to riders twelve (12) years of age and under. Riders to jump a simple course of eight (8) fences at 18". Horse/pony/rider combination may only cross enter into Short Stirrup Equitation and Junior Pleasure at the same show.

Low Schooling Jumpers. Open to all riders on horses and ponies. Courses must be run as Table IIa, Table IIb, Table IIc, or Table V (Optimum Time). Jumps to be at 2'. Time allowed will be generous (350m/min). (See USEF Rulebook for Table descriptions).

Intermediate Schooling Jumpers: Open to all riders on horses and ponies. Courses must be run as Table IIa, Table IIb, Table IIc, or Table V (Optimum Time). Jumps to be at 2'6". Time allowed to be generous (350m/min). (see USEF Rulebook for Table descriptions.)

High Schooling Jumpers: Open to all riders on horses and ponies. Courses must be run as Table IIa, Table IIb, Table IIc, or Table V (Optimum Time). Jumps to be at 3'. Time allowed will be generous (350m/min). (See USEF Rulebook for Table descriptions).

Walk/Trot Division: Open to junior and adult amateur riders on horses or ponies. Riders may not cross enter into any cantering or jumping classes. To consist of one walk Eq. class, one walk, trot Eq. class, and one walk, trot pleasure class.

TB Hunter Division: Open to Thoroughbred horses/ponies. Judged on performance, way of going and soundness. To be shown over rider's choice of fence heights: 2'3" or 2'9". Not to be combined with any other division.

AHS Hunter Derbies - \$10 entry payable to AHS. Entry fee will go to AHS Helping Hooves Fund which gives financial aid to members in need. Only open to AHS registered riders, horses and ponies that have competed this season at least three times in an AHS Show prior to this show. Horse or pony/rider combinations must also be entered and compete in an AHS division at this show. The Derby will run as a 2 round class. The first round is judged as a Hunter Classic with an emphasis on style and brilliance. The second round is judged as a handy hunter with emphasis on style brilliance and rideability. The top 8 competitors will be called back to ride in the second round. Courses may include rollbacks, long gallops, trot fences, and height options 3" greater than the class height. 2' Derby open to competitors showing 2'3" or lower this year. 2'6" Derby open to those showing 2'6" or over this year. Posted order. **Open Hunter Derby** - \$30 entry. Open to all who showed in a full division today regardless of AHS membership. Same course specs as AHS derby with 3 height sections. 2', 2'6", exhibitor's choice. Special ribbons to 8th.
