

SHORT STIRRUP EQUITATION DIVISION

Open to children 12 years of age and younger, on horses and ponies. Riders may not have competed in any show over fences exceeding 2'. Judged on hands, seat, general appearance, and control of mount.

SHORT STIRRUP HUNTER DIVISION

Open to riders 12 years of age and under. Horse/pony/rider combo may only cross enter into PLEASURE and SHORT STIRRUP EQUITATION at the same show. Fences 18"

JUNIOR/ADULT PLEASURE

Open to any type of pony or horse suitable for use as a pleasure mount. To be ridden by a Junior or Adult. Judged on performance, manners, and suitability of mount to rider. No martingales.

MODIFIED HUNTER

Open to all Junior and Adult Amateur riders on horses or ponies. Rider's may not have shown higher than 2'3" at any show. Fences 2'. May only cross enter into JR/ADULT PLEASURE ,BEGINNER EQ, or 2' EQUITATION, LONG STIRRUP at the same show. Horse and rider combination may not compete in division for more than 2 years

BABY GREEN HUNTER DIVISION

Open to horses & ponies that are in their 1st or 2nd year of showing over fences. Trotting corners not penalized. Ponies 2', Horses 2'3".

LOW SCHOOLING HUNTER DIVISION

Open to all riders on horses or ponies. Judged on performance, way of going, manners, and soundness. Fences at 2' or 2'3" at the rider's discretion. Designate height option on entry form. May be combined with HIGH SCHOOLING HUNTER.

HIGH SCHOOLING HUNTER DIVISION

Open to all riders on horses or ponies. Judged on performance, way of going, manners, and soundness. Fences at 2'6" or 3' at the rider's discretion. Designate height option on entry form. May be combined with LOW SCHOOLING HUNTER.

PRE-CHILDREN'S HUNTER PONY/HORSE DIVISIONS

Open to Jr. Riders still eligible for Nov. Eq. over fences at any USEF rated show (have not won 3 blue ribbons in eq) May not cross enter into any Children's Hunter classes on the same mount. Ponies to jump 2', horses 2'6". May be combined with PRE-ADULT HUNTER

PRE-ADULT HUNTER DIVISION

Open to Adult Amateur Riders on horses or ponies. May not cross enter into Modified or Long Stirrup at the same show. Fences 2'6" May be combined with PRE-CHILDREN'S PONY/HORSE.

NOVICE EQUITATION DIVISION

Open to Junior and Adult Amateur riders on horses or ponies. Riders may not have competed at 2'3" or higher. To be judged on hands, seat, and control of mount. Fences at 2' or 2'3" at riders discretion. May be combined with Open Equitation.

OPEN EQUITATION DIVISION

Open to Junior and Adult Amateur riders on horses or ponies. To be judged on hands, seat, and control of mount. Fences at 2'6" or 2'9" at riders discretion. May be combined with Novice Equitation.

THOROUGHBRED HUNTER DIVISION

Open to all horses or ponies that are full Thoroughbred. To be judged on hands, seat, and control of mount. Fences 2'3" or 2'9" at riders discretion. Not to be combined with any other division.

CHILDREN'S/ADULT HUNTER DIVISION

Open to horses and ponies ridden by Juniors and Adult Amateurs. Judged on manners, performance, way of going, and suitability of mount to rider Sm/Med. ponies 2', Large ponies 2'6", Horses & Adults 3'. Riders may not cross enter into any Pre-Children's Hunter class or division on the same mount.

LOW SCHOOLING JUMPERS

Open to all riders on horses and ponies. Jumps to be 2' or 2'3" at riders discretion (See USEF Rulebook for Table descriptions) Time allowed will be generous (350m/min). May be combined with High Schooling Jumpers.

HIGH SCHOOLING JUMPERS

Open to all riders on horses or ponies. Fences at 2'6" or 3' at rider's discretion. (See USEF Rulebook for Table descriptions) Time allowed will be generous (350/min). May be combined with Low Schooling Jumpers.

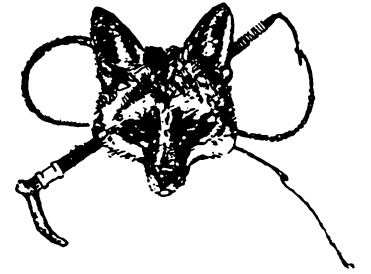
**AHS 2'6" HUNTER DERBY - \$20 payable to AHS
Entry fees collected will go into the AHS Helping Hooves
Fund which gives financial aid to members in need.**

Open to all horses and ponies who have been competing this year at 2'6" or higher and enter and pay in full for at least one division at this show. Horses and ponies may be ridden by any rider in the Derby. There will be no separate schooling for the Derby. The AHS Derby will run as a two round class. The first round is judged as a Hunter Classic with an emphasis on style and brilliance over a course of fences found typically in the hunt field. The second round is judged as a Handy Hunter with an emphasis placed on style, brilliance, and rideability. Top 8 competitors will be called back to ride in the second round. The 2'6" Derby will have 2'9" options.

DERBY PARTICIPANTS:

Riders do not need to be an AHS Member to compete in the Derby. Horse/Pony must compete in a division at the show in order to enter the Derby. If you wish to go for year-end points in the Derbies, then you must have a current AHS membership for horse, rider, and owner.

Anyone or any horse suspended from the USEF will not be permitted to exhibit in an AHS show.

Rider's age is as of Dec. 1st of the current show year.

3 people must compete in each class in order for full points to be given towards the AHS Year End Awards. Classes may run with 2 entries, awarding 3 points for first place, and 2 points for 2nd.

AHS Horse, rider, and owner registrations must be paid by the end of the day in order for points from this show to count towards year end awards. Registrations must be done on line at: www.associatedhorseshow.com

ASTM/SEI approved helmets must be worn by ALL riders when mounted.

CLASS & DIVISION DESCRIPTIONS

LEAD LINE DIVISION

Open to riders 6 years and under. Judged on manners and suitability of mount to rider. Not eligible for any other non-Lead Line classes. Will be asked to trot.

MINI-STIRRUP EQUITATION DIVISION

Open to children 8 years of age and under. May not cross enter into any jumping classes. Riders are eligible for any appropriate flat class.

LESSON MOUNT DIVISION

Open to riders on horses or ponies used solely in lesson programs. Judged on hands, seat, general appearance, and control of mount. Rider not to have competed higher than X rails at any show. May use any tack used in a schooling program.

WALK/TROT DIVISION

Open to Junior and Adult Amateur riders on horses or ponies. Riders may not cross enter into any cantering or jumping classes.

BEGINNER EQUITATION DIVISION

Open to riders under 18 years of age who have not shown in more than 8 shows in any one year. Rider's may not jump higher than 2' in any horse show, and may only cross enter into MODIFIED HUNTER or PLEASURE. May be combined with Long Stirrup.

LONG STIRRUP DIVISION

Open to Adult Amateur Riders on horses or ponies. Riders may not have jumped higher than 2'6" at any show. Not eligible for any other jumping except MODIFIED HUNTER. May Be combined w/BEG. EQ
