General Information

1. Entry fee: \$20.00 per class for entries received two days before the show. Post Entries \$22.00 per class. EMT Fee: \$10. Pre-registration ends June 3rd at 12:00PM
2. Neither the horse show committee nor Taylor Made Farm nor its associates will be responsible for any damage, injury or loss to persons, horse/pony or property of exhibitor or spectator incurred on or off the horse show grounds.
3. The management reserves the right to divide, combine, cancel, or charge the order of classes when necessary.
4. Anyone or any horse suspended from the USEF will not be permitted to show at an Associated Horse Show.
5. Classes for Juniors will be limited to riders who have not reached their 18th birthday prior to December 1st, 2022.
6. Trophy and six ribbons awarded in each class, with 8 Championship Divisions. No trophies awarded if less than 4 entries.
7. All riders must be wearing an ASTM approved helmet while mounted.
8. The decision of the Judge and/or Steward will be final.
9. No martingales permitted in under saddle classes.
10. Schooling permitted until 7:45AM.
11. All fence heights are approximate.
12. The show is generally held despite inclement weather but will be cancelled in case of extreme natural phenomena. Call if in doubt.
13. For your own safety, schooling may be regulated by the show management, dependent upon entries.
14. Three in a division MUST run as a division. A division with two entries may run for lesser points or be combined when appropriate.

Class Descriptions:

PRELIMINARY ADULT HUNTER

Open to adult amateur riders on either horses or ponies. Fences 2'6". Riders may not cross enter into Modified Hunter or Long Stirrup divisions at the same show.

DEVELOPING HUNTER

Open to all horses/ponies in their 1st or 2nd year of showing over fences.

Division to have walk/trot, walk/trot/canter, and 2 simple crossrails over fences classes. Simple changes and trotting corners not penalized. May cross enter into Baby Green.

MINI STIRRUP

Open to riders 8 years and under. Not eligible for any jumping classes at the same show.

BEGINNER EQUITATION

Open to junior riders who have not shown in more than 8 horse shows in any one year. May only cross enter into Junior Modified Hunter. Riders cannot have jumped higher than 2' in any horse show.

THOROUGHBRED HUNTER

Open to Thoroughbred horses/ponies. Judged on performance, way of going and soundness. To be shown over rider's choice of fence heights: 2'3" or 2'9". Not to be combined with any other division.

WALK-TROT

Open to junior and adult amateurs on horses or ponies. Riders may not cross enter into any cantering or jumping class. To consist of Walk Eq., Walk/Trot Eq., and Walk/Trot Pleasure.

BABY GREEN HUNTER

Open to horses/ponies who have not shown over fences in any class prior to December 1st of the preceding year. Ponies to jump 2'. Horses 2'3". Trotting in corners will not be penalized.

LEADLINE

Open to children 6 years of age or under. To be judged on manners and suitability of mount to rider. Will be asked to trot. Not eligible for any other non-leadline class.

LONG STIRRUP EQUITATION

Open to adult amateur riders on horses or ponies. Adults may not have jumped higher than 2'6" at any horse show. Riders are not eligible for any jumping classes other than Adult Modified Hunter. If entries do not warrant division to run, it may be combined with Beginner Eq.

SHORT STIRRUP HUNTER

Open to riders 12 years of age and under. Riders to jump a simple course of 8 fences at 18". Rider and horse/pony combination may only cross enter into Short Stirrup Equitation and Pleasure at the same show.

SHORT STIRRUP EQUITATION

Open to children 12 years and under who have not competed in any other show over fences exceeding 2'. Open to horses and ponies.

LESSON MOUNT

Open to riders on horses or ponies used solely in lesson programs. Judged on hands, seat, general appearance, and control. Riders may not have shown higher than crossrails at any show. Any tack permitted.

NOVICE EQUITATION

Open to junior or adult amateur riders on horses or ponies. Riders may not have competed at 2'3" or higher. Judged on hands, seat, and control of mount. Division will consist of two (2) over fences classes and one flat class. Fences 2' or 2'3" at rider's discretion.

OPEN EQUITATION

Open to junior or adult amateur riders on horses or ponies. Judged on hands, seat, and control of mount. Division will consist of two (2) over fences classes and one flat class. Fences 2'6" or 2'9" at rider's discretion.

PRE-CHILDREN'S HUNTER

Open to horses and ponies ridden by junior riders who have not won three or more blue ribbons in horsemanship over fences at any rated show. Judged on manners, performance, way of going and soundness. Ponies to jump 2'. Horses 2'6".

MODIFIED HUNTER

Open to all junior and adult amateur riders on horses or ponies. Fences 2'. Riders may not have shown higher than 2'3" in any show. May only cross enter into Long Stirrup, Beginner Eq., Pleasure and 2' Equitation at the same show. Trotting in corners will not be penalized

PLEASURE DIVISION

Open to any type of pony or horse suitable for use as a pleasure mount. To

be ridden by a junior or adult. Judged on performance, manners, and suitability of mount to rider. Division to have (3) classes; 1) Walk/Trot, 2) Walk/Trot/Canter, 3) Simple course of 4 poles or crossrails.

LOW SCHOOLING HUNTER

Open to all riders on horses or ponies. Fences 2' or 2'3" at rider's discretion.

HIGH SCHOOLING HUNTER

Open to all riders on horses or ponies. Fences 2'6" or 3' at rider's discretion.

LOW SCHOOLING JUMPERS

Open to all riders on horses and ponies. Jumps to be at 2' or 2'3" at riders' discretion. (See USEF Rulebook for table descriptions). Time allowed will be generous (350m/min). Can be combined with High Schooling Jumpers

HIGH SCHOOLING JUMPERS

Open to all riders on horses and ponies. Jumps to be at 2'6" or 3' at riders' discretion. (See USEF Rulebook for table descriptions). Time allowed will be generous (350m/min). Can be combined with Low Schooling Jumpers

AHS CLASSICS

Open to any horse or pony that have entered and competed in a full division at this show. The results of each Classic is a two score total. The third class of the division will count as the first round score of the designated Classic. Entrants must declare their intent to compete in a Classic before competing in the third round of the division to receive a score. All entrants are eligible to ride in the Classic regardless of their first round score. The Classics will run as open cards throughout the day as noted in the time schedule. Formal attire is welcomed, but not required. Any non AHS member may compete, but only AHS members will accrue year end points.

Class 91. **AHS LOW CLASSIC** will run with the 2' and 2'3" hunter divisions. Only horses/ponies that have been competing up to 2'3" are eligible.

Class 92. **AHS HIGH CLASSIC** will run with the 2'6" and higher hunter divisions. Only horses/ponies that have been competing at 2'6" or higher are eligible.
