

CLASS & DIVISION SPECS

JUNIOR/ADULT PLEASURE

Open to any type of pony or horse suitable for use as a pleasure mount. To be ridden by a Junior or Adult. Judged on performance, manners, and suitability of mount to rider. No martingales.

DEVELOPING HUNTER DIVISION

Open to horses and ponies that are in their 1st or 2nd year of showing. Trotting corners not penalized. To jump simple cross rail courses. May cross enter into Baby Green

BABY GREEN HUNTER DIVISION

Open to horses and ponies that are in their 1st or 2nd year of showing. Ponies to jump 2'. Horses to jump 2'3". Trotting corners will not be penalized.

PRE-CHILDREN'S /ADULT HUNTER DIVISION

Open to Jr. Riders still eligible for Nov. Eq. over fences at any USEF rated show (have not won 3 blue ribbons in eq) May not cross enter into any Children's Hunter classes on the same mount. Ponies to jump 2', horses 2'6".

THOROUGHBRED HUNTER DIVISION

Open to all horses or ponies that are full Thoroughbred. To be judged on performance, way of going, manners, and soundness. Fences 2'3" or 2'9" at riders discretion. Not to be combined with any other division.

NOVICE EQUITATION DIVISION

Open to Junior and Adult Amateur riders on horses or ponies. Riders may not have competed at 2'3" or higher. To be judged on hands, seat, and control of mount. Fences at 2' or 2'3" at riders discretion. May be combined with Open Equitation.

OPEN EQUITATION DIVISION

Open to Junior and Adult Amateur riders on horses or ponies. To be judged on hands, seat, and control of mount. Fences at 2'6" or 2'9" at riders discretion. May be combined with Novice Equitation.

LOW SCHOOLING HUNTER DIVISION

Open to all riders on horses or ponies. Judged on performance, way of going, manners, and soundness. Fences at 2' and 2'3" at the riders discretion. May be combined with HIGH SCHOOLING HUNTER.

HIGH SCHOOLING HUNTER DIVISION

Open to all riders on horses or ponies. Judged on performance, way of going, manners, and soundness. Fences at 2'6" or 3' at the riders. May be combined with LOW SCHOOLING HUNTER

LOW SCHOOLING JUMPER DIVISION

Open to all riders on horses or ponies. Jumps to be 2' or 2'3" at riders discretion. See USEF Rulebook for Table descriptions. time allowed will be generous (350m/min) May be combined with HIGH SCHOOLING JUMPERS

HIGH SCHOOLING JUMPER DIVISION

Open to all riders on horses or ponies. Jumps to be 2'3" or 3' at riders discretion. See USEF Rulebook for Table descriptions. time allowed will be generous (350m/min) May be combined with LOW SCHOOLING JUMPERS

OUTSIDE COURSE

The course will be open for schooling up until start time. In case of wet footing these classes will run in the white ring after the High Schooling Hunters. A Champion and Reserve ribbon will be awarded to the horse/rider combination accumulating the most points in classes #105-#109.

OPEN HUNTER OVER FENCES

Open to adults and juniors on horses or ponies to be ridden on an outside course over natural fences at a safe hunting pace. Fence heights optional 2' or 2'6".

HUNTER UNDER SADDLE

Open to horses and ponies ridden by adults or juniors to show under saddle at a walk, trot, and canter.

HUNTER HACK

Open to horses and ponies ridden by adults or juniors to show under saddle at a walk, trot, and canter. Individually jump 2 fences at 2'.

HUNTER PAIRS

Open to horses and ponies. To be ridden tandem, changing position at a posted position on the course. Fence heights optional 2' or 2'9".

HUNT TEAMS

Open to horses/ponies, tandem over the first part of the course, and abreast over the last two fences. Heights optional 2' or 2'9".

Pre-entries \$20.00 per rider per class. Entries close at noon on Saturday, October 28th. Post entries \$22 per rider per class

A Trophy and 6 ribbons will be awarded in each class, with 21 Championship Divisions.

Rider's age is as of Dec. 1st of the current show year.

The Horse Show Committee has the right to cancel, combine, or vary the order of the classes.

Three (3) exhibitors must compete in order for a Division to run with full points. If a Division has less than three (3) entries it will be combined with another designated Division. If that is not possible, the division will run with two (2) exhibitors and half points will be given towards year end awards.

By entering this Show, entrants agree that the Huntingdon Valley Hunt, Fox Heath Inc., AHS, The Show Committee, and Mrs. Richard Harris, et. al. are not responsible for any injury, accident, theft, or damage to any person, property, or animal in attendance. CLASS & DIVISION SPECS

AHS HUNTER CLASSICS

Open to any horse or pony that have entered and competed in a full division at this show. The results of each Classic is a two-score total. The third class of the division (noted with an *) will count as the first-round score of the designated Classic. The Classics will run as an open card after the third class of the eligible divisions. Entrants must declare their intent to compete in the Classic before competing in the third round of the division to receive a score. All entrants are eligible to ride in the Classic regardless of their first-round score. The Classics will run as open cards throughout the day as noted in the time schedule. Formal attire is welcome, but not required.

Any non-AHS member may compete in a Classic, but only AHS members will accrue year-end points.

Class #91 AHS LOW CLASSIC will run with the 2' and 2'3" hunter divisions. Only horses/ponies that have been competing up to 2'3" are eligible.

Class #92 AHS HIGH CLASSIC will run with the 2'6" and higher hunter divisions. Only horses/ponies that are competing at 2'6" or higher are eligible.

CLASS & DIVISION SPECS

LEAD LINE DIVISION

Open to riders aged 6 years and under. Judged on manners and suitability of mount to rider. Not eligible for any other non-Lead Line classes. Will be asked to trot. Division includes HALLOWEEN LEAD LINE.

HALLOWEEN LEAD LINE

Open to riders aged 6 years and under. Judged on manners and suitability of mount to rider. Judged 75% costume and 25% as a pleasure mount. Will not be asked to trot.

HALLOWEEN WALK/TROT/PLEASURE

Open to adults and juniors on horses and ponies. Judged 75% costume and 25% as a pleasure mount.

HALLOWEEN JUMPING

Open to adults and juniors on horses and ponies. To compete over a simple course of 4 cross rails. Rider and/or mount to be in costume. Judged 75% costume and 25% hunter.

MINI-STIRRUP DIVISION

Open to children 8 years of age and under. May not cross enter into any jumping classes. Riders are eligible for any appropriate flat class.

LESSON MOUNT DIVISION

Open to riders on horses/ponies that are solely used in a lesson program. Rider not to have competed higher than X rails at any show. Judged on hands, seat, and control of mount. May use any tack used in lesson program.

WALK/TROT DIVISION

Open to Junior and Adult Amateur riders on horses or ponies. Riders may not cross enter into any cantering or jumping classes.

BEGINNER EQUITATION DIVISION

Open to riders under 18 years of age that have not shown in more than 8 shows in any one year. Riders may not compete over fences exceeding 2' in any show, and may only cross enter into MODIFIED HUNTER, PLEASURE, and HALLOWEEN JUMPING. May be combined with LONG STIRRUP.

LONG STIRRUP DIVISION

Open to Adult Amateur riders on horses or ponies. Riders may not have jumped higher than 2'6" at any show. Not eligible for any other jumping classes except MODIFIED HUNTER. May be combined with BEGINNER EQUITATION.

SHORT STIRRUP EQUITATION DIVISION

Open to riders 12 yrs. of age or under on horses or ponies. Riders may not have competed in any show over fences exceeding 2'. Judged on hands, seat, and control of mount.

SHORT STIRRUP HUNTER DIVISION

Open to riders aged 12 yrs. and under to jump a course of eight fences at 18". Horse/pony/rider combination may only cross enter into JR/ADULT PLEASURE, SHORT STIRRUP EQUITATION, or the HALLOWEEN CLASSES.

MODIFIED HUNTER DIVISION

Open to adult and junior riders on horses & ponies. Riders may not have shown at 2'3" or higher. Fences 2'. May only cross enter into JR/ADULT PLEASURE, BEGINNER EQ., NOVICE EQUITATION, LONG STIRRUP, or HALLOWEEN CLASSES. Simple changes will not be penalized.
